Children have to be age 5 on or before September 30, 2017, in order to enroll in kindergarten for the 2017-2018 school year.

Thursday, April 27, 2017 ----- 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.**

**Prior to entering school, the following will need to be provided to the school:**

- 1) Proof of Residency (for example: electric, water, or cable bill)
- 2) Child's Birth Certificate
- 3) Commonwealth of Virginia School Entrance Health Form (MCH 213 G) from your doctor. This form must be completed 12 months prior to child's first day of school and includes child's complete immunization record and a well-child check *Code of Virginia § 22.1-270*
- 4) Proof of required immunizations listed below:
  - Four DPT (1 DPT must be after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
  - Four Polio (1dose must be after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
  - Two MMR (1<sup>st</sup> dose must be after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday)
  - Three Hepatitis B
  - Two Varicella (Chicken Pox vaccine) or doctor's documentation that child has had chicken pox
